

American Sign Language (ASL) Minor (18 units)

SERP 370A & SERP 370B (ASL I & 2) may **NOT** be used to satisfy any of the requirements below

SERP 370A and SERP 370B (ASL 1 & 2) are pre-requisites to SERP 431A and SERP 431B (ASL 3 & 4).

SERP 431B – American Sign Language IV – 4 units

SERP 433D* – ASL Literature and Film – 3 units (Spring Only)

* These courses are taught in a rotating sequence annually (fall or spring);
a grade of C or higher in SERP 431B is prerequisite to each.

**A maximum of 6 units of house numbered courses (391, 491, 399, 499, 499H and 493) may count towards this requirement.

Choosing this minor does not guarantee enrollment into any of the above courses. Students must be enrolled in SERP 431A (ASL 3) before declaring the minor.
