The internship provides opportunities for a range of school psychological services consistent with the National Association of School Psychologist (NASP) Domains of School Psychology Training and Practice, including varying types of assessment linked to intervention for academic, behavioral, and social/ emotional issues; consultation; behavior analysis and intervention; counseling; prevention at varying levels; research and program evaluation; and other activities

Under the supervision and direction of a Certified School Psychologist, the School Psychologist Intern will be responsible for creating and implementing a special education evaluation process aligned to IDEA and state guidelines.

Duties:

Assess student strengths and weaknesses within and in consideration of multiple environments for the purpose of determining present levels of academic and functional performance.

Evaluate and interpret student data to make recommendations for appropriate services within the full range of regular and special education programs.

Interpret individual test findings and recommendations to parents of students who are being considered for placement in special education programs.

Consult with teachers, administrators, and other professionals on specific diagnostic findings concerning students, in an effort to maximize educational development through placement or educational management.

Consult with parents concerning students' learning potentials, achievement levels and personality adjustments, and recommend ways of helping the students and providing sources of further professional assistance.

Make recommendations based on psychological findings in cases of exemption, retention, acceleration, and other placement situations.

Share in responsibility of reviewing incoming students' records to ensure compliance.

Assist in monitoring the accuracy of the school's special education census.

Keep informed of new developments in school psychology, educational practice, and special education law.
