Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive: We are a small district and work closely together. We meet weekly with all school psychologists to collaborate and problem solve. In our district, you will get a variety of experiences across all grade levels (or preferred grade levels/disability populations), including evaluations, consulting with special education and general education teachers, behavior intervention plans, counseling, and collaborating with the instructional coaches to analyze RTI data. You will work closely with school teams to meet special education deadlines and provide meaningful evaluation data for the students. We develop and present district professional development. We

work with school teams to increase understanding of the process of special education and special education law.
