Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive: An intern in our school system receives group supervision bi-weekly (2 hours) and a minimum of weekly (2 hours) supervision. This is all done while they cover a campus that has 3/4 of a typical caseload. At the beginning of the year, interns receive much more supervision as it is scaffolded and evolves to the minimum number as intern progresses and is able to do more on their own. We offer experiences with preschool and head start as part of our internship, but only offer High School experience if an intern seeks out this opportunity. Ultimately, we can cater an interns program

uniquely to make sure they get the experiences they want assuming that opportunity is available (which it typically is given we are a unified school district serving PK to HS).
