Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive: Deer Valley Interns are expected to cover a campus with appropriate supervision that is heavy at first and tapers. Interns that are hired in our district receive a great deal of supervision at both the individual and group level. Secondary supervision also takes place as there is a tremendous amount of support, especially early. As the intern progresses developmentally, the supervision fades but is always a minimum of 2 hours of face-to-face with an individual supervisor and 1 hour of group supervision. These hours are weekly. Interns help to cover preschool screenings and have various other supervised experiences. They attend regularly scheduled staff training and are all highly encouraged to attend AASP. Any experience an intern wants to have in our district, we will cater that experience to make

it happen so that each individual intern can experience what they need to culminate their training experience.
