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Teacher Certification	 \$30 per certification and endorsement included on IR \$60 per item not included on IR (e.g., if you do not meet bilingual endorsement requirements by graduation and apply on your own later) 	 ATA will cover items listed on IR Request for Initial Certification Fee Waiver - Family Income: Used for those whose family income does not exceed 200% of the current federal poverty guidelines. Request for Initial Certification Fee Waiver - Military Eligibility: Used for active military and spouses and those who have been honorably discharged within the last 2 years.
