Flowing Wells Unified School District staff will provide a well rounded opportunities for our school psychologist interns. Our plan is to provide an opportunity to learn leadership skills and the necessary indicator performance skills in NASP's framework under the supervision of a nationally certified well-experienced school psychologist. Our inter assignments are a cross between side-by-side work at a site and assigned areas or grade levels at a site. Our interns will meet weekly with a supervisor and Director of Exceptional Student Services to problem solve, talk trough cases, review documentation, model and practice strategies for communication with all stakeholders, receive feedback, goal track and reflection for measured growth in your work as a school psychologist, and gain an understanding of how the NASP performance indicator framework is lived through our work with students, staff, and the community. Our goal is to prepare you to walk into a school psychologist position with confidence, tools/strategies, skills, and an understanding of how to be a good school psychologist grounded in evidenced based strategies, and how you can have a greater impact on your schools, students, and the community.
