Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive: Interns will be placed full-time at a campus with a reduced caseload. Thus, they will have the full range of school psychology experiences in Gilbert. As Gilbert Public Schools values the comprehensive role of a school psychologist, interns will be expected to complete evaluations, consult with teachers, help lead the MTSS process on their campus, be involved in PBIS and provide other mental health and behavioral supports.

Additionally, the interns will be part of a large group of school psychologists that are well connected and supportive to one another. Opportunities to observe and assist with the preschool evaluation process, as well as activities at the secondary level are also available.
