What are intern assignments from day 1? at own school full time with supervision 2 hours weekly

Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive: Full-time interns are placed in two schools for 4.5 days with 0.5 day set aside for supervision. Granite school psychologists provide a wide range of supports including evaluation, consultation, individual and group

counseling, direct behavior support, crisis management, and others. We are a large district (over 60,000 students) and are a majority-minority school district with more diversity than would be expected of Utah. Our school psychologists work with school social workers with significant crossover in roles, particularly in Tier 2. Most interns are in elementary settings, but secondary placements are often an option. Our interns unilaterally report feeling supported, and we retain a high rate of interns into career positions.

What other information should intern candidates know about your district or internship experience that is not listed here? Many of our interns have come from out-of-state because of the experiences we provide. Some came with no intention of making Utah their home after internship but have stayed with us as career school psychologists. Even though we are not the highest paying district in Utah (we are competitive in salary and have exceptional benefits), we do not lose school psychologists to other districts. I believe this is largely because we support our school psychologists and they feel like they have reasonable flexibility in their practice. We have figured out how to become a cohesive staff in spite of the tendency for school psychologists to work in isolation.
