Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive: The intern will work in a dynamic team environment in a rural location. Experiences will include psycho-educational assessments with a variety of age levels and different populations. The responsibility level is scaled up over time with scaffolding available at all times. The number of evaluations will not exceed more than approximately 2/3 of a typical case load. The intern will have the opportunity to provide consultation to school stakeholders in many areas including response to intervention, functional behavioral analysis and the design of behavioral intervention plans. Other opportunities include counseling sessions for individuals and groups. Humboldt County School District Psychology staff attend local, state and national professional development opportunities including the NASP conference

and LRP, depending on the interest of the individual. The intern will work in an office off of a school site with other school psychologists and other special education personnel allowing for collaboration and brain storming sessions in the moment.
