Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive: The intern will work 3 days a week at a K-8 school that serves approximately 900 students. (A second, non-supervising school psychologist will also work at this school site and share responsibilities). On the remaining 2 days of the week the intern will work side-by-side with the supervisor at the supervisor's discretion. This will allow the intern to sample a variety of experiences.

What other information should intern candidates know about your district or internship experience that is not listed here? The intern supervisor is the current School Psychologist of the Year of the Arizona Association of School Psychologists. The director of the special education department is a certified school psychologist and previous recipient of the Administrator of the Year from the Arizona Association of School Psychologists. Interns sign an employment contract. They are expected to accumulate a minimum of 1200 hours, but actually work closer to 1500 as they are employed for the full school year. This is a long-standing internship experience in a diverse, Title 1 school community with an extremely strong school psychology department. Following internship, the district has a 100% rate of full employment in Laveen or in a neighboring district.
