Interns receive a wide variety of experiences to include such things as evaluation of a variety of populations, consultation/MTSS, behavior support, counseling, screening/implementing/monitoring academic and behavioral interventions, exposure to multiple self-contained programs, preschool if interested. The district is willing to work with interns to support experiences in their particular areas of interest or areas in which they feel that they need extra exposure even if it can't be done at their primary campus. We encourage interns to get experiences across the district.

Interns are assigned to their own school. However, they do receive an increased amount of support (in addition to their 2 hours a week of supervision) in the early weeks/months of internship until they feel comfortable at their campuses.
