Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive:

Interns in the Marana Unified School District will receive a plethora of opportunities across all grade levels. Interns change placement each quarter and are therefore able to work in each grade level setting including Preschool, Elementary, Middle School, and High School. We have two alternative high schools, an Edp program with two sites (one for elementary and one for secondary), as well as a more intensive program for students with significant delays at two sites (one for elementary and one for secondary). MUSD has a behavior support team that conducts FBAs, writes BIPs, and helps staff to implement the intervention. Interns will work with this behavior team during the year as well as shadow the Threat Management Team.
