Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive:

This year, our interns were at their own school full time with supervision from one of our psychologists. The amount of supervision that interns received exceeded the minimum requirement and provided a gradual release of responsibility. Though it is not yet finalized, next year we would like to pair our interns with existing psychologists so they would be side-by-side at the supervisor's school full time. This would include coordination between school sites so that interns get a wide range of experiences while still being supported.
