Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive: Interns will be at their own school with a minimum of 2 hours of supervision per week. The supervisor will attend meetings and provide more support in the beginning of the year, support will fade as independence blossoms. Supervisors are selected for their experience and leadership roles within the district. Interns will participate in a district on-boarding session where they will be introduced to district roles and procedures, sessions will be weekly in the beginning and become less frequent as the year progresses. This time offers additional support and didactic training and allows time to collaborate with colleagues and build relationships with other psychologists.
