Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive: We aim to provide a broad experience for our interns to observe and practice all facets of the school psychologist's role, starting with observation and shifting to independent practice, in an effort to foster the skills and experience needed to be a certified school psychologist. We have our interns working at a site with their supervisor. Starting in the 2nd quarter, our interns go on a "rotation" one day per week to another school in our district to broaden their experience (e.g., if an intern's primary assignment is at one of our elementary schools, they will spend one day per week during the 2nd quarter at a high school; one day per week during the 3rd quarter with our preschool assessment team; and one day per week during the 4th quarter at a school that houses one of our specialized programs).

What other information should intern candidates know about your district or internship experience that is not listed here? Our district has been implementing NASP's comprehensive practice model for about 10 years now, in which our school psychologists provide direct services to students with social/emotional/behavioral needs in addition to the "traditional" role of conducting evaluations. I think this model helps better connect our school psychologists to our campuses and allows us to practice all of the various skills we learn in our school psychology program. In order to effectively participate in this model, we have at least one full time school psychologist at every campus, and many campuses also have a behavior interventionist that helps partner to provide these services. We are also in our 2nd year of utilizing Q-interactive assessments with iPads to help make the testing process more efficient.
