Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive: The Sunnyside Unified School District (SUSD) prides itself in working with interns to build an individually tailored internship experience. Interns along with their primary supervisor work to collaboratively develop an Internship Plan that addresses the NASP Ten Domains of Practice while also promoting individual areas of focus for professional growth. Interns will learn from a diverse and multidisciplinary team of professionals who promote a broad developmental training approach to achieve training goals. Emphasis is placed on training interns in culturally competent practice across all areas including mental health, assessment, intervention, collaboration, and consultation. SUSD provides for experiences within the entire special education continuum and at all grade levels (preschool through high school). Many former interns take advantage of working alongside our Autism Assessment and/or Bilingual School Psychology Teams. Interns will be assigned a primary supervisor and will have opportunities to receive both individual and group supervision.
