Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive: Interns working with Tempe Union High School District will have the experience of working through Student Success Teams, conducting psycho-educational evaluations, providing group and/or individual counseling as well as participating in MET and IEP meetings. Further, interns will have the opportunity to develop behavior intervention plans and conduct functional behavior assessments. Professional development opportunities are offered throughout the year in conjunction with monthly School Psychologist meetings for collaboration with other professionals.

Historically, interns have shared a site with their supervisor or another veteran Psychologist but we are looking to determine what is the best model so this year will be a combination of both. Regarding salary, you are paid as though you are an hourly employee and required to clock in and out daily and for lunch. If you work all hours within the year you can reach the 2000 hours; however, this may be less depending on your needs. Interns are expected to work 5-days per week and be on campus when students are present.
