

You should see your counselor at least 1 time this year. *Freshman*

Ask a counselor to review your personal statement. *Senior*

Register and take the ACTs.
Junior (not always required but good to have, asked for in certain colleges @ UA, not @NAU ASU)

Ask what sort of after school programs you can join. *Sophomore*

You should see your counselor at least 4 times this year. *Junior*

Ask for help in designing your job resume to find jobs. *Sophomore*

Ask for help finding scholarships you can apply for. *Junior*

You should see your counselor at least 2 times this year. *Sophomore*

This year in HS, you should see your counselor as often as needed, maybe even once a month. *Senior*

You should start looking for college information sessions your parents could attend? *Senior*

Ask how you can be more involved in your classes.
Freshman

Introduce yourself to the counselor and share your high school plan. *Freshman*

Fill out the FAFSA.
Junior

Register and take the SATs.
Junior ~exceptions to requirement

Ask for letters of recommendation. *Senior*

Are there tours to the UA I can take to learn more about their programs? *Junior*

Create a list of universities, application costs, and application deadlines.

Junior

Create a list of who you want to ask to write your Letters of Recommendation.

Junior

Ask about taking the PSAT this year.

Sophomore

Ask if you are on-track for college with your course choices.

Freshman & Sophomore

Start compiling a portfolio of your awards, certificates, club recognitions, and resume.

Sophomore

If attending the UA, register in Scholarship Universe.

Junior

What extracurricular activities should I participate in to stay on track?

Sophomore

Ask if there are college prep programs at the UA, PCC, or at your school that will help you with applications and forms.

Senior

Ask for help finding colleges that specialize in your career choices.

Sophomore

Last chance to ask for help finding scholarships you can apply for.

Senior

Share your career goals with a counselor.

Freshman

Fill out college applications.
